STAT 200 (GQ) Elementary Statistics (4)	Please consult a PSU adviser. Students are encouraged to select the Penn State course.
ENGL 202, A, B, C, or D Effective Writing (3) Only one course must be taken.	ENGL 102 (3), or 104 (3), or 106 (3) Only one course must be taken.
CAS 100 (GWS) Effective Speech (3)	SPCH 101 Effective Speaking (3)
General Quantification (GQ) (3) Students must complete three credits in this category. MATH 021 College Algebra is often selected, but other courses also meet this requirement. Students should select a course with a GQ designation.	MATH 103 College Algebra I is often selected for this category, but several other courses also meet this requirement. Consult an adviser or the PSU transfer credit guide.
General Arts (GA) (6) Students must complete six credits in this category. Students should select a PSU course with a GA designation.	Several HACC courses meet this requirement. Consult a PSU adviser or the PSU transfer credit guide.

General Humanities (GH) Students must complete six credits in this category. Students should select a course with a GH designation.

Several HACC courses meet this requirement. Consult a PSU adviser or the PSU transfer credit guide.

General Natural Science (GN) Students must complete three credits in this category. Students should select a course with a GN designation.

Several HACC course meet this requirement. Consult a PSU adviser or the PSU transfer credit guide. In many cases, students do not need to complete this course because other required science courses meet this requirement.

Additional comments:

- HACC pre-clinical and clinical nursing students may register for up to two nursing electives at Penn State Harrisburg while still pursuing an associate degree education. Students intending to pursue the NURN program need six credits of nursing electives. These courses are generally available three times a year on a variety of different schedules to accommodate students. Topics vary each semester, but may include NURS 409: Forensic Nursing, NURS 402: Holistic Health, NURS 464: Death and Dying, and NURS 407: Drugs of Abuse to name a few.
- Students have the ability through portfolio/verification to earn up to 33 Penn State credits toward completion of the NURN degree.
- General education and nursing classes required for the NURN program are currently offered at Penn State Harrisburg, Hershey Medical Center, and Holy Spirit Hospital.
