TRIP REGISTRATION

Deposit: \$200 - Non-refundable

Your deposit will assure your reservation with the hotel and other suppliers. Your deposit can be paid online via credit card or electronic check. If you are paying by regular check, payment must be sent with a copy of your passport as soon as your registration has been made online.

Payments:

Half due November 14, 2011 (\$750 if deposit paid prior, \$950 if no deposit paid). Final payment of \$950 or remaining balance due January 13, 2012. Credit card or debit card payments will be accepted by WorldStrides Capstone, or you may pay by electronic check through WorldStrides Capstone

Late Fees:

A late fee of \$40 per person will be assessed if payments are not received within seven (7) days of their respective due dates unless advance arrangements have been made. These arrangements and requests must be made in writing to WorldStrides Capstone.

Cancellation penalties:

All cancellations must be sent in writing via e-mail or fax to WorldStrides Capstone. Cancellations are effective on the date they are received by WorldStrides Capstone. GROUND SERVICES DEPOSIT: The \$200 per person Ground Services is non-refundable. CANCELLATIONS RECEIVED 31 TO 60 DAYS PRIOR TO DEPARTURE: For any cancellations received between January 2 and February 1, 2012, WorldStrides will retain 50% of the Ground Services portion of the program fee (\$950). CANCELLATIONS WITHIN 30 DAYS OF DEPARTURE (OR NO-SHOW): Cancellations received February 2, 2012 and after are subject to a cancellation fee equal to 100% of the Ground Services fee (\$1,900). Course registration is separate from trip registration. Upon receipt of your deposit, WorldStrides Capstone will send you a receipt that you must present at the Penn State Harrisburg Registrar's Office to register for the course.

The objective of this course is to provide finance students with exposure to the international capital markets, in particular the United Kingdom's. Modern financial markets are complex and global, and due to their rapid integration, it is essential for finance students to have exposure to them. While in London, students will become familiar with the U.K. banking system, and financial and derivatives markets.

Course Registration - To register for course credit:

- 1) Meet with your academic advisor to discuss how this course will impact your educational progress. Have your advisor sign a drop/add form to add this class. Forms are available online at registrar.psu.edu/registration/dropping_courses.cfm.
- 2) Contact WorldStrides Capstone (worldstrides.org/university) to register and pay the deposit or total cost for the trip and obtain a receipt from the agency.
- 3) Bring your signed drop/add form and your travel agency receipt to the Registrar's Office in Swatara Building to complete enrollment in the course.

Course requirements:

Mandatory pre/post-trip meetings, group reading, journals, etc., during spring 2012 term.

LONDON ITINERARY

Itinerary and visits subject to change without notice.

Day 1 • Friday, March 2

Secure your overnight flight to London, Heathrow Airport.

Day 2 • Saturday, March 3 – Arrival London

Arrival – London Heathrow Airport by Noon for transfer to the hotel. Check into the hotel for seven nights. Half-day guided walking tour of the financial district. You will be provided with a seven-day Tube Pass for travel around the city.

Day 3 • Sunday, March 4

Morning guided sightseeing tour with a visit to The Tower of London and British Museum. Afternoon on your own.

Day 4 • Monday, March 5

Morning guided tour to visit Westminster Abbey and St. Paul's Cathedral. Afternoon visit to Lloyds of London.

Day 5 • Tuesday, March 6

Morning visit to Ernst & Young or AIG (or similar company). Afternoon visit to Morgan Stanley or London Stock Exchange.

Day 6 • Wednesday, March 7

Travel to Oxford University for a full-day visit.

Day 7 • Thursday, March 8

Morning visit to JP Morgan. Afternoon visit to British Banker's Association.

Day 8 • Friday, March 9

Morning visit to NYSE Liffe. Self-guided tour of the Bank of England Museum in the afternoon.

Day 9 • Saturday, March 10

Check out of hotel and store luggage with concierge. OPTIONAL full day excursion to Bath and Stonehenge (additional \$150 per person + entrance fees). Return to hotel following optional excursion and transfer to London Heathrow for return to U.S.
